DDSP's SFC Serra named DLA Senior NCO of the Quarter

SFC Felix Serra, USA, is the Defense Logistics Agency's (DLA) Senior Noncommissioned Officer of the Quarter for the first quarter of fiscal year 2006.

SFC Serra serves as the Noncommissioned Officer (NCO) in Charge for the Aerial Delivery and Textile Section of Defense Distribution Depot, Susquehanna, Pa. (DDSP) From October to December 2005, Serra supervised and provided technical guidance to six NCOs and 21 civilians in the inspection, repair, modification and fabrication of aerial delivery equipment for DLA and the airborne community.

SFC Serra supervised the technical rigger inspections on more than 7,000 individual pieces of equipment, the receipt and stowage of almost 3,000 line times and the packing and shipment of over 3,400 Material Release Orders (MROs) with zero defects.

With superior foresight, SFC Serra established and executed 24-hour shifts to accommodate the short-fused, late night packaging of 556 cargo slings which were shipped overnight and used to drop sandbags to repair levees and control the

flooding in the Gulf region after Hurricane Katrina. In addition, he executed the record turn-around rigging of 178 air pallets containing blankets, tents, and other humanitarian aid items in support of the U.S. military relief effort in areas Pakistan affected by an earthquake.

"His outstanding professional performance and leadership ability have been exemplary," said CAPT Jim Naber, SC, USN, DDSP Commander. "His dedication and integrity are beyond reproach and he continually sets the highest example for his Soldiers to follow."

SFC Serra is also a member of the prestigious Sergeant Audie Murphy Club.
