A primary level field activity of the Defense Logistics Agency, DLA Distribution is the leading provider of global distribution support to America's military including receiving, storing and issuing supplies as well as providing other tailored services to increase warfighter readiness.

DLA Distribution offers best value supply chain solutions through a broad range of services including storage, distribution, customized kits and specialized packaging as well as transportation support and technology development. DLA Distribution's customers include U.S. Army, Marine Corps, Navy, Air Force and other agencies.

More than 10,000 employees provide timely distribution services to customers around the globe. In 2010, DLA Distribution processed over 22.9 million receipts and issues supporting customer requirements worldwide, to include Operation New Dawn and Operation Enduring Freedom, numerous humanitarian assistance missions and a multitude of military exercises to ensure warfighter readiness.

2010 marked a historical moment in DLA Distribution history as the organization deployed its expeditionary team in support of contingency operations to Kandahar, Afghanistan, responding to a Request for Forces from the Secretary of Defense. This unique deployable capability provides customers in theater with an agile, flexible distribution option while reducing reliance on strategic airlift.

DLA Distribution Quick Facts:

- Oversees the operation of a network of 26 distribution centers worldwide to include expeditionary capability.
- Stores over 3 million items, valued at over \$101 billion, in over 75 million sq. ft. of storage space.
- Services over 243,700 customers worldwide.
- Maintains over 145 dedicated truck routes to over 500 locations.
