DDJC to host site for disaster exercise

Stockton, Calif. – (May 7, 2009) – The Defense Distribution Depot, San Joaquin, or DDJC, is the host site for an anti-terrorism exercise taking place May 13 to determine response effectiveness in this type of disaster and cooperation with other agencies/organizations, using the common incident command system.

Agencies involved in the exercise include Lathrop Police Department, Tracy Fire Department, Tracy Police Department, Office of Emergency Services, San Joaquin County Sheriff, and Tracy Sutter Hospital.

DDJC is the Department of Defense's West Coast Strategic Distribution Platform providing military services with clothing, food, medical items, electrical and electronic products, construction supplies and repair parts. DDJC is one of 25 distribution centers belonging to the Defense Distribution Center located in New Cumberland, Pa.
